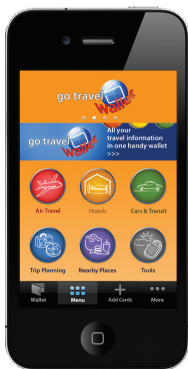
the history of our group, which would concentrate on its fiduciary activities."
